

Call for Papers

We are pleased to announce this year's Economic Science Association European Conference 2012. The conference is hosted by the University of Cologne, and will be held at the University Campus from **September 12**th to 15th.

We welcome submissions of research using experimental methods to learn about economic behavior. Submissions related to economic experiments are welcome by scholars in economics, psychology, neuroscience, and other disciplines. This year, we particularly encourage submissions in the field of "Bounded Ethicality".

In 1982 Güth, Schmittberger, and Schwarze published their seminal paper on the **ultimatum** game. The experiments were conducted at the University of Cologne. We will celebrate this **30**th anniversary and invite submissions of papers that review insights from the ultimatum game and/or deal with new results.

Submission

Researchers who want to present their work at the conference are invited to submit a short abstract (not exceeding 250 words, including title, affiliation and co-authors) until **June 17**th. To make your submission (1) Log onto the ESA website, (2) Click on the conference link, and (3) Click the "Submit" button and follow the instructions. Note that membership fee is only due when you will register and not when you submit your paper.

Registration

All participants (including non-presenters) need to register for the conference at the ESA webpage. To be able to register, you need to be a member of the Economic Science Association.

Early registration (until July 15th) fees: \$400/faculty and \$300/students.

Late registration (until July 29th) fees: \$500/faculty and \$400/students.
